Jacob Cole was born during 1852 in Illinois.¹ Not much is known about Jacob except that he shows up in the 1880 Census in Leadville, where he is listed as a pawn broker.² In the 1880 census Cole is living at 212 Harrison Avenue with Herman Pollitz, a Jewish attorney.³ Jacob Cole, the pawn broker, does not appear in any city directories.⁴ There is confusion about Jacob Cole because there seems to be two of them.

The other Jacob Cole was also born in 1852,⁵ but in New York, not Illinois.⁶ The 1879 city directory records Cole working as a bookkeeper for the Tontine Restaurant.⁷ The following year, he worked for Jacob Schloss, once again as a bookkeeper.⁸ Cole also appears in the 1880 census in Leadville, where he is listed as living with Jacob Schloss at 216 west 5th Street.⁹ Jacob Schloss was a prominent Leadville merchant active in the liquor business. Cole does not appear in the census or city directories after 1880.

It is probable Jacob from Illinois and Jacob from New York were the same person listed in the census twice.
