Isaac Eisner was born in Missouri in 1860 to Charles S. Eisner, an immigrant from Fraustadt, Prussia, ¹ and New York-born Rosetta Londoner, daughter of the German immigrant Herman Londoner. ² Isaac's father's birthplace is today known as Wschowa and is located within the borders of modern day Poland. Herman was also the father of Wolfe, Julius, Moses, and Joseph Londoner, though he settled in Denver unlike his sons and their families who came to Leadville. ³ Isaac remained in Missouri for the first 20 years of his life, from 1860 until 1880, when he made his way to Leadville to join his extended family.

Leadville's city directories first record Isaac's presence in 1880, showing him working as a clerk for the Londoner family's grocery store named Londoner & Eckles, located on Oak Street.⁴ In August 1882, the municipal court fined him for stealing a ship chronometer, a sextant, and jewelry from Captain Ed C. Sandall in the aftermath of a

fire on Chestnut Street, which occurred in 1881.⁵ Despite these unsavory actions, Isaac remained in Leadville working directly under Moses through 1883. After this year, he is absent from city directories, censuses, and newspapers until 1891.6 He returned to Leadville in that year and started working with Moses Londoner at his new business at 616 Harrison Avenue. Though 1891 was the final year he appeared in Leadville's city directories, he is found in a list of registered voters published in the May 6, 1893 edition of the Leadville Evening Chronicle.⁸ Over the course of his years in the city, Isaac lived at the Londoner grocery on Oak Street, 9 at 214 East 3rd Street, 10 and at Moses Londoner's 616 Harrison Avenue grocery.11

Isaac moved frequently after leaving Leadville, primarily throughout the Midwest though he did briefly return to Colorado in 1900. He married Etta Marie Stocum in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on September 12, 1893 and together had one child a year later, Marcia R. Eisner. Haac died on July 24, 1909 in Chicago. He is buried at Maple Hill Cemetery in Hartford, Michigan alongside Etta who passed away in 1941.
