Saul Seligsberg Born: Bavaria, 1844

Died:

Saul Seligsberg was likely a Leadville resident for only a few months during 1880. Curiously he is listed in the 1880 Leadville city directory, published in June, the same month he was enumerated in the 1880 United States census in Ruby City, Colorado, where he owned a dry goods store. During his time in Leadville, Saul was

employed as a bookkeeper at the clothing, consignment and auction enterprise belonging to David May and Moses Shoenberg while residing at 136 W. 3rd Street.⁵ No records for Saul can be found after 1880 and a newspaper report from Irwin, Colorado, indicates he was suffering from a "…hemorrhage of the lungs.", on July First.⁶ It is possible he did not survive the ailment.

¹ Although the directory was published in June, the data was collected over the preceding months. He was counted in Ruby City by a U.S. census enumerator on June 17, 1880.
