Ed L. Stein (Stine) Occupation: Jeweler

Ed Stein was a purportedly "well known jeweler of New York" who came to Leadville in November, 1883. Despite the assertion by the *Leadville Daily Herald* that Ed was a well-known jeweler, no individual matching his name and profession appears in the 1880 US Census in New York.

Upon arriving in Leadville, Ed began working for local jeweler Sol Rice² whose business was located on the second story of 321 Harrison Avenue just above the prominent Monheimer family's clothing store.³ Ed was not listed in city directories or in the 1885 Colorado Census, indicating that his stay in Leadville was brief. Due to a lack of vital records, it is not known where Ed moved to after leaving Leadville.

Despite both Ed L. Stein and Samuel Stein having lived in Leadville in the same year, there is no indication that they were related.

Little is known of Samuel Stein and his time in Leadville. He first appeared on a guest list for a New Year's party hosted by Samuel Mayer⁴ and attended by some of Leadville's most notable Jewish citizens.⁵ Samuel's only listing in Leadville's city directories was in 1883 which noted him as a clerk working for Myers Harris,⁶ a Jewish clothing store owner.⁷ According to the 1883

directory, Samuel Stein also resided at 125 Harrison Avenue, the same address as Samuel Mayer's pawn shop.⁸ Any professional or personal relationship between Samuel Stein and Samuel Mayer is not known, however.

Samuel Stein was seemingly in Leadville only briefly as he does not appear in the 1880 US Census in Colorado, the 1885 Colorado Census, or in any further local historical records.

Despite both Ed L. Stein and Samuel Stein having lived in Leadville in the same year, there is no indication that they were related.
